Subject: Earmarking of resources under IAY for natural calamities — modification reg.

The undersigned is directed to say that with the approval of competent authority, it has been decided to modify the para 4.4.1 of the guidelines which deals with keeping apart 5% of the IAY funds to meet exigencies arising out of natural calamities and other emergent situations. The existing provisions in Para 4.4.1 of the guidelines and the amendment of para is as under:

Existing Provision

5% of the total allocated funds under IAY will be kept apart to meet the exigencies arising out of natural calamities and other emergent situations like riot, arson, fire, rehabilitation under exceptional circumstances etc. with a district-wise ceiling of 10% of annual allocation (including State share) or Rs.70.00 lakh whichever is higher.

Proposals for this purpose have to come from State Governments/Admn. of UTs showing the extent of damage and the estimated fund requirement in respect of the proposed IAY houses provided assistance for construction of a house has not been obtained from other source. The upper limit shall be 10% of the district's annual

5% of the total allocated funds under IAY will be kept apart to meet the exigencies arising out of natural calamities and other emergent situations like riot, arson, fire, rehabilitation under exceptional circumstances etc. with a State-wise ceiling of 10% of annual allocation (including State share)

Proposals for this purpose have to come from State Governments/Admn. of UTs showing the extent of damage and the estimated fund requirement in respect of the proposed IAY houses provided assistance has not been obtained from other sources. In case of occurrence of calamities in any part of any State, funds

allocation or Rs. 70.00 lakh, whichever is higher. However, his will be within the overall ceiling of 5% funds kept apart for natural calamities. The relief will be as per the norms with regard to per unit ceiling of assistance for an IAY house prescribed under the scheme.

under this component of IAY will be made available to those districts with the limit of 50% of the normal allocation for each district which will again be subjected to a ceiling of 10% of State allocation under IAY.

Necessary instructions to all District Collectors and DRDAs may be issued accordingly. These instructions will be applicable from financial year 2011-12 i.e. from the current financial year.

As you may be aware, Reserve Bank of India has issued instructions to all the Nationalised Banks to disburse loans to IAY beneficiaries under Differential Rate of Interest (DRI) scheme from 2008-09 onwards. Under DRI and IAY beneficiary can borrow upto Rs. 20,000/- from any Nationalised Bank at 4% interest per annum to top up the unit assistance that he has got under IAY.

This has been communicated to all the State Governments through various communications and forums / meetings. However, while reviewing the progress made by various States in respect of ensuring that benefits of DRI scheme flow to IAY beneficiaries, it has been found that not much awareness has been created about this new initiative. This has resulted in only a meagre number of IAY beneficiaries availing of this benefit.

You are therefore requested to create widespread awareness of this benefit as well as to ensure that DRDA officials help IAY beneficiaries to avail of this loan. To begin with, it is expected that at least 25% of IAY beneficiaries would be able to avail the benefit under DRI scheme during the current year.

I shall be grateful if immediate action is taken in this regard and data in respect of those who have availed of the DRI benefit is uploaded every meanth in MPR-3.
